6. In the collage titled *The Unsuspecting* the snake is watching a potential meal. Can you see what is **camouflaged** in the leaves?
7. Can you find a **carnivorous mammal**?
8. How many creatures can you find in the collage titled *Furry Friends*?
9. Which animals in the collages are **nocturnal**? Which animals are **diurnal**?
10. There are two butterflies in the collage titled *Joy Palette*. Can you find the one that is **camouflaged**?

4. What is the difference between a **frog** and a **toad**? How are they similar? (Check out *Summer Dip* and *Toadstools*)
5. Rabbits have long ears to help them hear. The other function of their long ears is thermoregulation. What is **thermoregulation**?
6. What wild **canines** live in the area? Hint: One of them is in a collage.

1. If you could be one of the animals in these collages, which would you choose to be, and why?
2. Animals are born knowing things. For example, Monarch butterflies know when and where to fly during migration. Animals also learn from the adult animals that raise them.
